Our integrative healing work will explore an ongoing, resonant and co-creative relationship between somatically oriented trauma methods and systemic constellation work. We are to offer new windows of opportunity for a deeper understanding of our organizational human condition, along with expanded options for healing broken connections and resolving hidden entanglements that may lead to traumatic repetitions throughout time and space.
